- Mowing prior to the workshop
- Ample supply of clean water (i.e. no chemicals) for cleaning stones
- Pea stone*** (Leaning Workshops only)
- Live sand*** (Leaning Workshops only)
- Parking area for participants
- Payment to MOCA of not more than \$ 100 for D/2 biological cleaning solution
- Local Advertising/Workshop Promotion
- Continued post-workshop cemetery care
- Coordination of registrations with MOCA online and/or paper registrations.

WORKSHOP FAQs

- Cemetery Preservation Workshops I & II will be presented by trained MOCA participants and will involve cleaning stones and (optionally) straightening leaning TABLET stones (more than 15 degrees lean). Tablet stones have NO BASES either on top of the ground or underground. Each workshop is approximately 4 hours.
- Suggested workshop group of 20 is not geographically restricted to residents of town/county.
- Whenever possible, workshop locations should be visible from the road or very close by to allow access for participants and materials.
- Advertising will suggest a donation payable to the host group to be used toward the cost of supplies. [e.g. \$20 per participant]
- Participants will provide their own lunch and if possible "tools" as listed in the pre-workshop info.
